Announcements:

The 2020 Census is here! By now you should have received four mailings including a hardcopy of the 2020 Census. Thank you to everyone who has completed the 2020 Census helping Cecil Township achieve a 61.1% response rate as of April 28, 2020. We are less than 8% away from beating the 2010 response rate either online, by phone, or by paper form. Our response rate is 6.3% ahead of Pennsylvania as a whole and 7.7% ahead of the national response rate of 53.4%. If you have a PO Box and *have not* received a paper form through the mail, please visit our website for how-to steps to complete the 2020 Census: www.ceciltownship-pa.gov.

RESOLUTIONS:

#087-2020 Consider declaring a state of emergency for Cecil Township as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic retroactively effective March 16, 2020 until rescinded by the Board.

#088-2020 Consider extending the collection period for tax imposed on the assessed value of real estate at the Township's prescribed discount rate of 2% through July 31, 2020 and waive any fees or penalties associated with the late payment of the tax imposed on the assessed value of real estate, provided that the tax is paid in its entirety by December 31, 2020.

#089-2020 Consider application for Payment No. 1 in the amount of \$94,673.26 to Traffic Control & Engineering Company for work on the Southpointe Boulevard Signal Upgrades Contract between 11-14-2019 and 1-24-20 as recommended by the Township Engineer. A request for reimbursement of this payment will be made through PennDOT from the Green Light Go Grant for the project.

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RESOLUTIONS: (continued)

#090-2020 Consider application for Payment No. 2 in the amount of \$82,029.60 to Traffic Control & Engineering Company for work on the Southpointe Boulevard Signal Upgrades Contract between 1-25-20 and 3-20-20 as recommended by the Township Engineer. A request for reimbursement of this payment will be made through PennDOT from the Green Light Go Grant for the project.

#091-2020 Consider authorizing the Township Manager to approve invoices for payment and make requests for reimbursement through PennDOT for the Green Light Go Grant for signal upgrades along Southpointe Boulevard. Construction has been delayed due to COVID-19 and the grant period ends on 5-31-20 before the June Supervisors Meeting. A motion for ratification of the manager's actions will be presented at the June Supervisors Meeting.

#092-2020 Consider adopting the standard DEP Resolution for the Planning Module Component 2 for individual on-lot sewage disposal systems servicing two new lots in the Checca Acres Subdivision II Plan. The Planning Module has been approved by the Washington County Sewage Council.

#093-2020 Consider adopting the standard DEP Resolution for the Planning Module for sanitary sewers servicing new home construction at 50 Hillview Street, Canonsburg, PA 15317. The Planning Module has been approved by the Cecil Township Municipal Authority and the Canonsburg-Houston Joint Authority.

#094-2020 Consider the Holding Tank Agreement for William Robison, 716 Route 980, McDonald, PA, 15057. The holding tank has been permitted by the Washington County Sewage Council.

#095-2020 Consider Subdivision Application #2020-0003 for the Bell Plan of Lots, contingent upon the Planning Module Exemption being signed by the Cecil Township Municipal Authority. Location: 27 Wilson Avenue, R-2 Medium Density Residential Zoning District, Applicant: Richard Todd and Kara Jo Bell. The plan received Planning Commission approval on February 20, 2020, contingent upon addressing comments from the Township Engineer.
