

# Cecil Township Parks & Recreation Board Meeting Minutes

Thursday, May 2, 2019

**Proceedings:** Meeting called to order at 6:41 p.m.

- 1) **Meeting minutes:** from April 4, 2019 approved, motion by Bonnie and seconded by Diana.
- 2) **Easter Egg Hunt:** 4/6/19 – 198 total count – the Magician was good. Hunt was moved to the parking lot. We need to purchase more chocolate pieces to give out. Some people with small children took the allergy bags as they were more toddler friendly. We need to shorten the time frame, people with different age children may not want to stay so long. The Easter Bunny was great, thank you Glenn!
- 3) **Touch-A-Truck:** Plan to be there around 9 a.m. and get the coffee started first. The new steam table will be delivered next week, the old one has already been moved out. Someone from baseball adjusted the temperature of the refrigerator and it is working fine now. Menu is hot dogs, hamburgers, popcorn, pretzels, drinks. Amy will see if a boy scout will be Chase. Bados Pizza Truck asked to be able to participate by selling food (pizza/hoagies, cannoli). No one was willing to make a motion to have Bados food truck. Jacque will let him know. Trucks are expected to arrive between 9 and 10 a.m. Jimmy will talk to the police department and make sure all is in order. Glenn, Jim, Mark, Barb, Suzanne, Jack and Cindy Fisher will be there.
- 4) **Fall Festival:** Vendor apps are on the Facebook page, the due date is 8/1/19. Glenn motioned to hire the train from 12-5 both days, Diana seconded, approved. Cindy Fisher knows someone who will bring in dancers if we want. No one was interested in making a motion to have Froggy at the festival. Washington County has a Facebook page with 45,000 members, we can advertise there. Jim will contact Mr. Cerenza (sp?) about parking options.
- 5) **Updates on park improvements:** The bridge closest to the township building has been raised and secured. The tennis courts have not been done yet due to weather. Jacque gave a report on Lawrence Park. Bill Bottorff gave him an update-the basketball court has been cleared and sealed and hoops have been ordered. No estimate on surface yet. Cars have been moved to the far side of the property, so they are separate from the park. That property is leased from St. John the Baptist church. Bill and Frank talked to Fr. DeVille from Holy Rosary Church about the baseball field there. The bleachers belong to Holy Rosary. Also Bill Bottorff gave Jacque info on playground equipment that Bill suggested the township purchase, it has a good price break through 6/5. Information was passed around. None of the Parks Board Members were willing to make a recommendation based on this limited time notice and that none of them had seen this before, but some members suggested that it is really up to the Board of Supervisors, anyway. There was some heated discussion that led to some discord among those in attendance. Bonnie suggested that we move on. After more heated discussion it was suggested that we move on in a constructive manner. Jim asked about the South Vue parcels, the township is investigating. Little Library, Wendy and Cindy Fisher are working on that.

- 7) **General:** Accounts: One set up at Canonsburg SNS, Sam's doesn't do that, Mark is waiting to hear back from Guyton's.
