

Fire Protection System Inspection & Reporting Policy

Fire Protection System Inspection, Testing & Maintenance

All fire protection systems in Cecil Township are required by the fire code to be inspected, tested, and maintained on regular intervals. Please see the fire code for schedule (<https://ceciltownship-pa.gov/vertical/sites/%7B3946EAA3-618F-4FF9-A842-AB9D3DC62B58%7D/uploads/2015-ifc.pdf>). The purpose of these inspections is to ensure the system will operate properly in the event of an incident, ensuring a safe environment by minimizing the risk of life and property loss.

Cecil Township has contracted with BRYCER, LLC to help manage the fire protection systems inspection, testing, and maintenance program. All contractors who perform inspections, testing and maintenance services of fire protection systems are required to electronically submit all compliant and non-compliant reports to the department via www.TheComplianceEngine.com.
